



Hi Parents!

We are so excited to be able to tell you about a new security feature being added to our Children's Ministry. It will serve to keep your child safe and keep you informed.

Beginning Sunday, April 18 a new check-in procedure will be introduced.

- **Bring your child downstairs:** You will need to deliver your child (ages 3, 4 & 5 year olds; and grades K - 4th) to the "Dig site" (a.k.a. basement.)
- **Sign in:** When you arrive at the dig site, you will find a sign in table in the main cave area.
- **Nametag for child, pick-up tag for you:** At the table we will log your child in and give the child a nametag. On the nametag, your child's name, your location, and any food allergy will need to be listed. At this time, you will receive a pick-up tag. It has a number matching your child's. You must retain this tag and bring it back to pick up your child. This same pick-up tag will be used if you pick-up at the end of Sunday School, during or after snack time, OR after Children's Church. **IMPORTANT ****Please verify that the nametag has been highlighted in red if your child does have a food allergy******
- **Drop off in classroom:** After you have received the nametag and placed it on your child and received your pick-up tag, you will continue on and drop your child off at his/her classroom.

The significant changes are; you will need to drop your child off in person and you will need a pick-up tag when you come to get the child.

Here is a schedule reminder.

9:05 - 9:15 Drop off at Sunday School Classes

10:10 - 10:25 Kids are transferred to fellowship hall and given a light snack

10:25 Parents pick-up their children and bring them into church for worship time. Pastor Paul has a Kid Connect time and dismissed the children to the Children's Church leaders. They are led to Children's Church and kept there until the end of the regular church service.

End of Adult Church Service After the adult service is done, one parent (with a verification pick-up tag) goes to the Children's Church area and picks up his child.
